



Driving from Franklin Street/Carolina Inn, follow Pittsboro Street and cross S. Columbia Street at the traffic signal. You are now on Manning Drive. Take the first right (West Drive; one way street). Turn right onto Mason Farm Road. Look for a tall brick building ahead on the left (EPA building); the MBRB is on the right. Limited parking may be found along Mason Farm Rd. Pay parking for visitors is located at the Ambulatory Care Center and the Dogwood Parking Deck. The MBRB is connected to the Neuroscience Research Building.

Walking from Franklin Street/Carolina Inn, go south on Columbia Street. Turn left onto Manning Drive. Look for a large brick staircase across Manning Drive on the left side of Thurston-Bowles, between the curb and the bus stop shelter. Take the staircase up to an outdoor courtyard with tables. walk straight through the courtyard. You are looking at the MBRB, a tall brick building with a curved, two-story patio, silver wall sconces, and a round planter near the entrance. The MBRB is connected to the Neuroscience Research Building.

Parking Information - Directions to MBRB

- Dogwood Parking is three tenths of a mile on the right. **To reach the Medical Biomolecular Research Building (MBRB):** Take the steps on the left side of Thurston-Bowles. The Thurston-Bowles building is on the corner of Columbia Street and Manning Drive, on the same side as the parking decks. Both Neuroscience and MBRB are located behind Thurston-Bowles, across the courtyard.
- Ambulatory Care Center Lot off of Mason Farm Road. **To reach the Medical Biomolecular Research Building (MBRB):** Walk across Mason Farm Road and follow the path around the Glaxo Building.
