

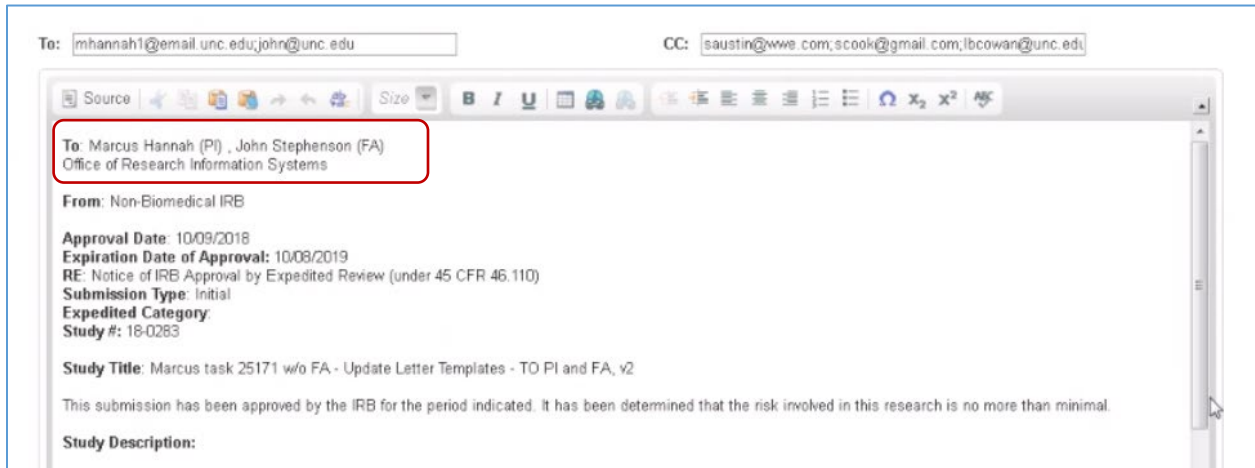
IRBIS changes, effective 5:30 PM, October 9, 2018

IRBIS 5.09.17 Update:

When PIs are responding to stipulations, the IRB Reviewers name will now be shown as IRB Admin.

A bug in the updated view caused the name of the stip author to be shown.

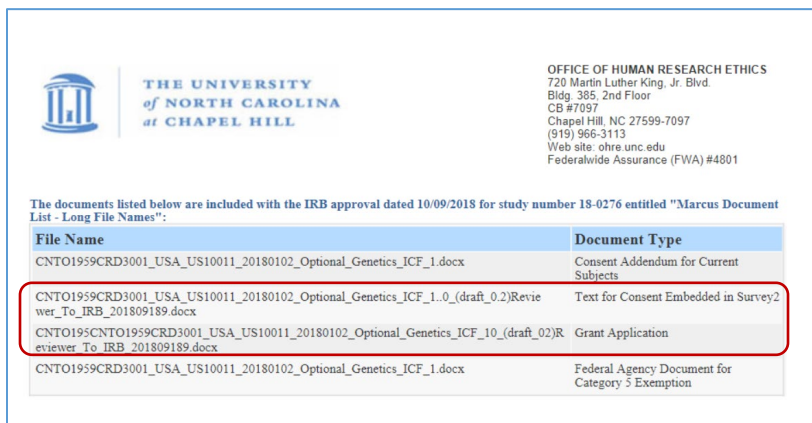
Creation of new PI and FA tags (ex: Jack Slattery (FA)) to the letter templates:



The prior update had only added their address to the To: box. This will include the names and titles in the letter text.

The ability to Close Emergency Use HUDs has been added. As they are a special subset of NHSR, they had previously been blocked. But because they are marked as Approved, rather than NHSR, they need the ability to close.

Long file names wrap on approved document list:



Finally, we are adding study level tags. None will be visible to start, but you will see the area where they will be managed. I will send out an additional update once we are ready to begin populating them.
