Live on PRODUCTION - HOTFIXED IN 5.10.04.00:

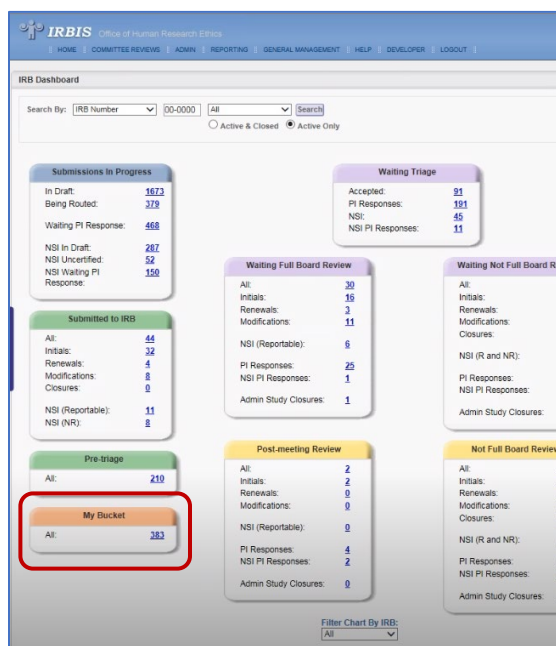

- Reviewing will include all submission currently under admin review.
- Watching (indicated by a star icon) will include any submission which you have manually indicated that you want to watch.
 - Watching can be toggles on or off via the My Bucket view or via the Study History screen.
 - The watch request will expire when the submission has been finalized. If we find that we wish the watch request to remain, this process will be reevaluated.
- Waiting PI Responses will include anything currently on the researcher side.

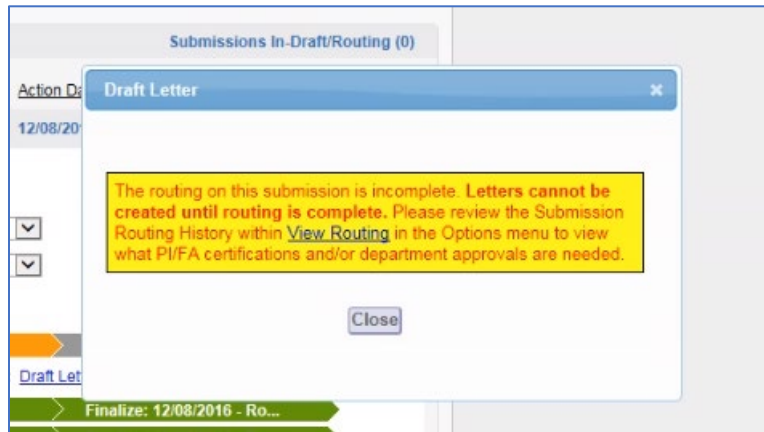
Additional default watching capabilities for NSI related items or other areas (TBD) are still being planned.

Submissions in draft or currently being routed for studies already reviewed by the IRB will now be displayed in the admin view.

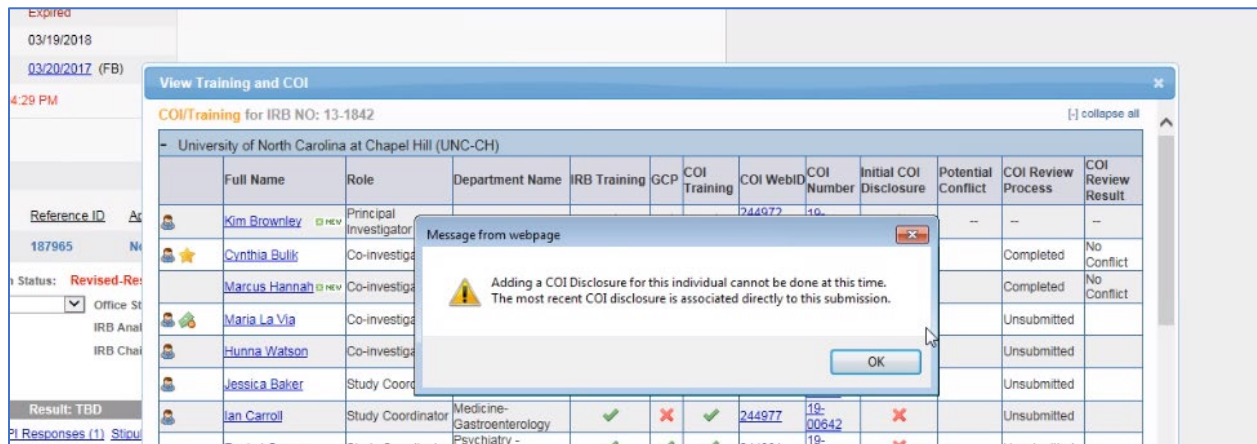
