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## IRBIS 5.11.05 Update:

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### IRB Acceptance Process Revisions

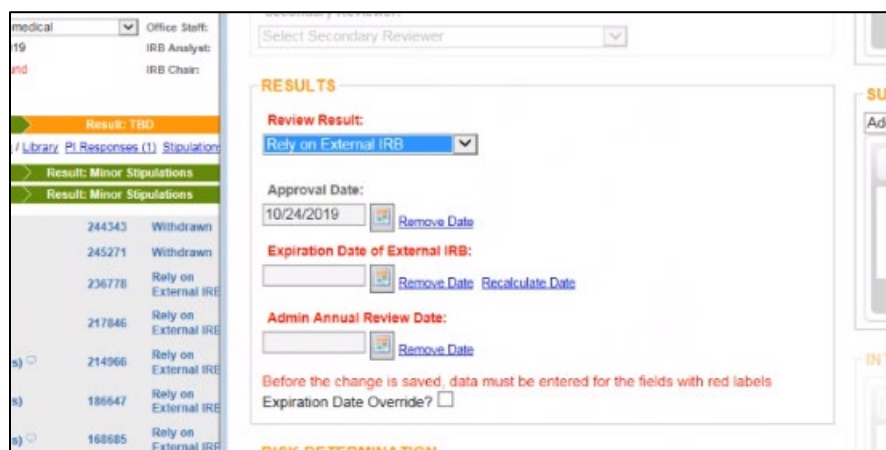
The Submitted to IRB, 'Accept for Review' and Pre-Triage, 'Mark Ready For Triage' steps in the IRB process have been automated. This process will run hourly, on the hour. As such studies which reach the Routing Complete status should be accepted for review and appear in the Waiting Triage bucket within one hour.

We may revise this process in the future to take into account University Holidays and Weekends depending on how the metrics are impacted, but for now this process will run seven days per week, 24 hours a day.

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### IRB Rely on External & Rely on NCI-CIRB

For studies that have the review result of Rely on External or Rely on NCI-CIRB, the review results screen will no longer auto populate the Expiration Date of the External IRB nor the Admin Annual Review Date.

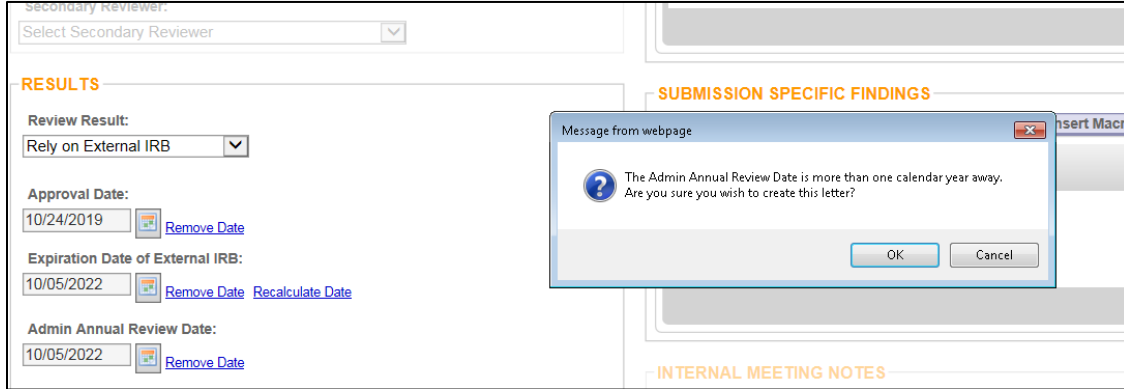


When an Expiration Date of the External IRB is entered, that date is automatically populated in the Admin Annual Review Date field. In the event the Admin Annual Review Date is different than the date indicated in the Expiration Date of the External IRB field, a new date can then be entered.
